Co-Imagine Arts - Facilitated Workshop Offerings at The Path: LAByrrinth at Hebrew College
The Path: LAByrrinth, created by artist Shirah Rubin, invites personal reflection and community connections. It encourages a walking meditation that invites you to enhance Jewish spiritual practice. How are we paying attention to our dreams, purpose, and belonging to community? This experience is a catalyst for conversation and community building.

A labyrinth is an ancient archetype found across history in diverse cultures. Unique to Rubin's labyrinth are ceramic Listening Vessels to accompany you on your walk. The benches at the center welcome you to sit and to engage in sacred listening with your inner self and others. How do we listen with empathy and understanding?

Work alongside artist, Shirah Rubin, for a facilitated walk and develop a unique and meaningful workshop for your organization or community. Why walk a labyrinth?

- 1) It provides an opportunity for listening and contemplation.
- 2) For community and connection. A place to gather to share journeys and to support one another.
- 3) Promotes creative inspiration and insight inner wisdom

Option 1: Guided LAByrrinth Walks for Reflection and Dialogue

The workshop includes a guided labyrinth walk and a facilitated group debrief to foster shared insights.

This collaborative program combines the reflective journey of a labyrinth walk with engaging hands-on art activities such as collage or journal making. Participants will engage in a facilitated walk, individual creative process and a concluding group reflection.
